# 2011 Canal Cities Orienteering Festival (early August) Great Success!!

ROC hosted the Orienteering USA national convention in early August. To say it was a success is a major understatement! The week in Rochester was sandwiched between A-Meets in Syracuse (CNYO) and Buffalo (BFLO) on the weekends.

A total of 145 people participated in the convention in Rochester; 255 attended the CNYO meet, while 180 people competed in the BFLO meet. Of all of the people participating in some aspect of the Orienteering Festival, a whopping 90% were from outside of the Rochester area. Thirty-one states plus the District of Columbia were represented; in addition, there was a good turnout of Canadians (28 from Ontario and 6 from Quebec).

The week in Rochester included daily seminars about many aspects of orienteering (held at the Cornall Cooperative Extension on Highland Avenue); daily Sprint courses and training exercises (see article by Linda Kohn about these); a Night-O at Mendon; a mountain-bike-O at Dryer Rd Park; a canoe-O at Genesee Waterways Center; and the US Trail-O Championships at Highland Park. In addition, there were non-orienteering activities such as a family night at Sea Breeze amusement park.

# Next Meet: Saturday, October 15 Irondequoit Bay Park West

The next meet will be at Irondequoit Bay Park West, located on the southwestern shore of Irondequoit Bay. ### General information on local meets

#### Courses

The club uses the USOF "color" designations wherever applicable. A description of the courses is as follows:

Color	White	Yellow	Orange	Brown	Green	Red	Blue

The White course is intended to be easy enough for first-time participants after a short introduction to the sport. Control points are generally on trails or similarly easy-to-locate features.

The <u>Yellow</u> course is slightly more difficult than the White course. Control points are generally placed close to but not right at easy-to-find features, such as on a knoll that is 50 m away from a trail junction.

The <u>Orange</u> course requires more map-reading and course-planning skills than the Yellow course. Controls will generally have a good attack point, but the attack point may be more subtle than on the Yellow course, or the control will be placed further from the attack point. The route choice from one control to the attack point for the next control is often less obvious than on the Yellow course.

The <u>Brown</u>, <u>Green</u>, <u>Red</u>, and <u>Blue</u> courses differ from each other only in length. At local parks, they are usually the most difficult course that can be set given the size and the terrain of the park. Map-reading, compass, and route-planning skills will be tested to a greater degree on this course.

Sometimes other courses may be offered, such as a Motala (a course which involves one or more map exchanges), or a Line-O or Score-O. These courses will be explained in the meet instructions at any meet that uses these formats.

### Entry fees

The entry fees to ROC meets are \$3.00 per individual or group for ROC members and \$6.00 for non-members. If several people (a family group for example) enter as a group using the same map, the fee is still \$3.00 (members) or \$6.00 (non-members). Additional maps are available for \$1.00 each. A person or group can do a second course using the same map for no additional charge (if you complete the White course and decide to try the Yellow course, for example).

### Beginner instruction

Beginners are always welcome; there is an informal beginners' clinic approximately 15 minutes after the beginning of the event, and all meets offer a course suitable for beginning orienteers.

# Sprint Series Championships Results by Steve Tylock

A Lyons and Stevens have been in the top three of the Men's Open for each of the three years of the Club Sprint Championship series. Mike Lyons has had a second and third place finish, but this time around we find Nate Lyons in first place. Rob Stevens won the inaugural event, and earns his second silver this year. Sergey Dobretsov rounds out in third, bouncing back into the top three after missing the podium in 2010.

Stina Bridgeman makes it three for three winning the Women's Open class. Linda Kohn earns second place after moving up to open.

Vince Cassano wins the Men's 45+ class after a solid finish in the last race of the season, moving ahead of perennial favorite Dick Detwiler. Vince competed in the 45+ class this year after a solid fifth place in the open class in 2010. Dick earns second place after first and third place finishes - if this were baseball, we'd have a term for that! Peter Dady places third for our CNYO neighbors.

Richard Burgy earns his second first place in the Male 65+ class while Anne Schwartz wins the Women's 55+ class. Walt and Patty Lyons take a pair of second place finishes back to BFLO.

In the youth category, Zach Lyons finishes in first place finish for the Male 16 and under class - taking another virtual gold medal back to the family trophy case. Tim Dobretsov earns second, moving up from third place in 2010.

That wraps things up for 2011 Sprints, but stay tuned for the Club Championship finishing up over three races in October.

### Training Sessions at the Convention Linda Kohn

As the person in charge of designing the training exercises for the convention I started by (what else?) checking the Internet. I found the website with all sorts of training exercises sorted by topic. I then determined which activities would be suited for each of the four parks that were being used. Once I had that figured out I simply needed to plug in the activities, right? It turned out to be not quite so cut and dried. Many changes ensued when I started figuring out where to put the courses. In the end it all came together nicely with only a couple of glitches...not including the printer running out of yellow toner resulting in very pink/blue maps at Webster!

I thought some of the training exercises were very fun and that people seemed to really enjoy then. The corridor "O" at Mendon was certainly challenging, as was the circle map exercise. I had experienced corridor "O" but never had done the circle map. I made the circle map by taking off all of the north-oriented objects, north lines, trails and lettering forcing the runners to look at and use the contours. I also rotated the map so that north wasn't at the top of the page and wrote instructions in a circle around the map. This did require that I hone my skills with OCAD since these are functions that aren't usual in course setting and map making.

The opposite of the corridor "O" (where only a strip of the map showing 50 meters on either side of the line is shown) was the compass exercise. Instead of showing the map between controls the area on either side of the line was blocked out making it necessary to navigate by compass. In hindsight I shouldn't have used the steep part of Letchworth for this exercise...I'll know better next time.

Webster Park, the final day of training, was highlighted by Mass Start Practice. Runners were given one of four different maps that had some common controls with forking (i.e. sending runners to different controls). This made for some wild running since the courses were only 1.2k long. This was a very enthusiastic group with most runners doing both the A loop and the B. Thanks to Tyler's

incredible computer skills we were able to see results on the monitor almost instantaneously.

Each of the four days there was a sprint course offered but these were set by Rob Holmes (Mendon), Tyler Borden (Durand), Kathy Bannister (Letchworth) and Dick Detwiler (Webster). The courses were excellent and provided all of our runners with a great experience. Many thanks to everybody who pitched in to help set controls, make sure everything ran smoothly, and keep Linda from self-destructing. Many thanks to Tyler for setting up and manning the results computer for all four days. People were impressed!

# New Orienteering Race Format -"Trail Challenge"

You may have noticed a type of event that was offered at the last two Sprint meets (Genesee Valley Park and Highland Park) called a "Trail Challenge".

This was pioneered in ROC by Tyler Borden at the Genesee Valley meet.

Basically, a Trail Challenge is is a mass start cross-country race over fields and trails with a difference, as compared to cross-country races or trail races. The course is not marked out by marshals and cones but is instead defined by checkpoints (controls) that are marked on a specially made color map. The term Trail Challenge arises from choosing the fastest route between them.

The intent of this format is to appeal to people who might be decent runners but don't have much (or maybe no) orienteering experience. They may find a White or Yellow course too short to be a physical challenge, but an advanced course like Green or Red to be frustrating navigationally.

A Trail Challenge is ideally about a White to Yellow technical level, but with longer legs, and longer in general. Distances offered at Genesee Valley were 3K, 6K, and 10K; at Highland Park, one distance of 6K was offered.

An interesting feature about the Trail Challenge format is that following (technically not allowed in most orienteering events) is not only permitted, but encouraged. This led to some interesting head-to-head competition at the Highland Park meet.


